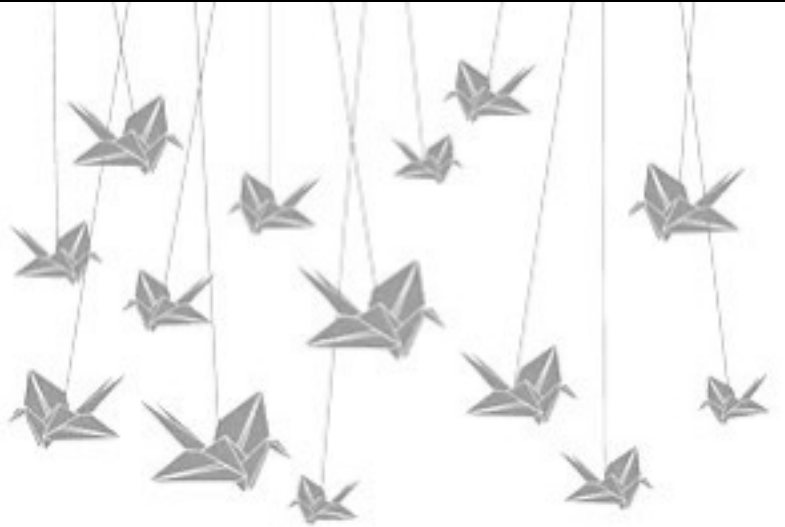


# To the people of Hiroshima and Nagasaki:

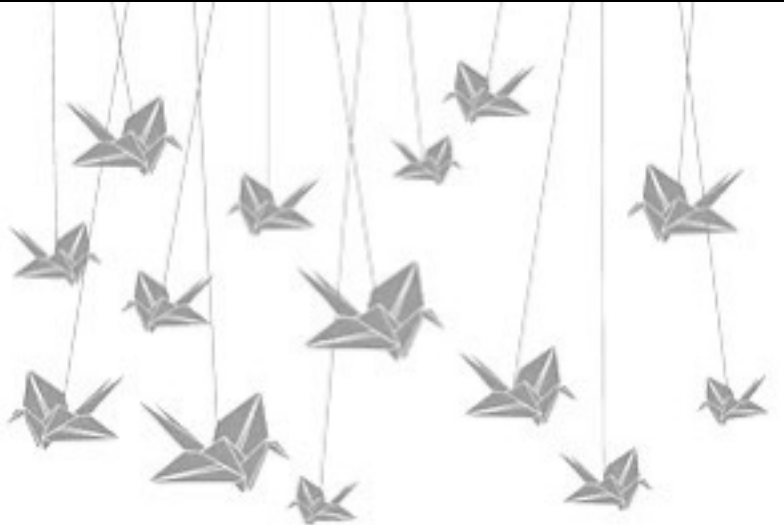
