# President Obama: Work Towards a Nuclear Free World

In Prague in April, 2009, President Obama committed the U.S. to this goal: "I state clearly and with conviction America's commitment to seek the peace and security of a world without nuclear weapons."

Then, in May 2016, President Obama became the first sitting U.S. President to visit Hiroshima. In mourning the victims of the U.S. nuclear attack, which caused the deaths of almost 60 million people in the span of 10 years through first direct impact and then radiation poisoning, President Obama said of these victims "*They ask us to look inward to take stock of who we are and what we might become.*"

**Under President Obama's current nuclear proposals, we will become a threat to our own country and world - and we would become responsible for more nuclear proliferation and insecurity.**

President Obama has proposed rebuilding all three legs of the U.S. nuclear triad – strategic bombers, intercontinental ballistic missiles (ICBMs), and nuclear-armed submarines (SLBMs), calling for spending \$350 billion over the next decade and up to \$1 trillion over the next 30 years. Military experts agree that we cannot afford these costs and we can be just as secure, and probably more so, with far fewer nuclear weapons.

**SIGN BELOW** to tell President Obama to keep his promise to the American people, and to the world: we must END plans to modernize our nuclear weapons arsenal, IMPLEMENT the non-proliferation treaty, COMMIT to the U.S. never being the first to use a nuclear weapon in war, and take OFF of hair-trigger alert the hundreds of nuclear weapons currently on hair-trigger alert.
